ORLANDO, Fla. (April 30, 2025) – Habitat for Humanity Greater Orlando & Osceola County announces a grant from State Farm that will help the nonprofit continue its mission of creating stable, affordable housing in Central Florida.

Money from the grant will go toward purchasing building materials and supplies to build new construction homes. The grant helps Habitat homeowners like Rickie achieve their goals of purchasing stable places for their families to live and thrive for generations.

Rickie, a grandfather approaching retirement, recently closed on his Habitat home. He said becoming a homeowner is an investment in his family's future.

"I have to pinch myself several times pulling up to the house and have sat outside the door in tears of fulfillment," Rickie said. "From an emotional standpoint, it's satisfying. Financially, the investment into my grandchildren's future is empowering."

State Farm and Habitat Orlando & Osceola have a long history of collaboration, including State Farm providing grants to increase hurricane preparedness efforts in our community. And last week, eight members of the State Farm team volunteered on our build site helping to install siding on a Habitat home under construction.
