

We pioneer housing solutions.

HOME OWNERSHIP PROGRAM

Our Homeownership Program sells homes with stable mortgages to local families. Applicants must show a housing need, the ability to pay, and a willingness to partner with us. Homes are built with energy-efficient and aging-in-place features. Our Innovation line looks for alternatives to single-family homes, such as accessory dwelling units (ADUs) and multi-family housing.

PRESERVATION PROGRAM

Our Preservation Program works to keep homeowners (both Habitat and non-Habitat) in their homes. We partner with local governments to provide roof replacements at no cost to qualified homeowners as well as critical repairs to help residents recover from disasters. We also help homeowners reduce their home insurance costs.

In its first year, every dollar invested providing free home inspections generated \$6.91 in savings on home insurance premiums.

\$1 → \$6.91 = \$903

That equals an average annual savings of \$903 per household.

Julie's Story

Julie struggled with home maintenance after her husband's passing. She faced an unmanageable insurance premium of \$6,600. Through our **Preservation Program**, she replaced her roof at no cost. Then after free inspections secured a more affordable policy, reduced her premium to \$2,800, a more than 50% decrease. This not only ensured her home was secure during hurricane season but also provided her with peace of mind and additional savings.



Quarlisa's Story

Determined to change her family's cramped living conditions, Quarlisa, who works at a local jail, embarked on a journey toward homeownership with Habitat Orlando & Osceola. She attended a First-time Homebuyer Workshop and began taking control of her finances. Housing counseling helped her qualify for the Homeownership Program. Habitat U classes further set her up for success. "My vision for the future is to enjoy the rest of my life watching my children really grow and be happy with what they accomplish. This home will help me create it," she said.


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EDUCATION

Our free public classes cover topics that are key to improving financial health and being a successful homeowner. We also teach financial literacy and community engagement to teenagers through our Youth Summit.

Class topics include:

- Home Maintenance
- Disaster Preparedness and Home Insurance
- Community Engagement





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CERTIFIED FIRST-TIME HOMEBUYER WORKSHOPS

Certified First-time Homebuyer Workshops, offered monthly in both English and Spanish, help people become homebuyer-ready and qualify for certain down payment assistance programs.

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HOUSING COUNSELING

Housing Counseling, through free one-on-one sessions, helps people achieve their housing goals, whether it's to become a homeowner (through Habitat or open market), prevent foreclosure, or maintain their existing home. We are a HUD-certified Local Housing Counseling Agency.

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ORANGE COUNTY FINANCIAL EMPOWERMENT CENTER

We provide free one-on-one financial counseling to anyone who lives or works in Orange County, empowering them to take control of their finances.

We transform communities.

The housing crisis isn't just about a shortage of homes, it's about a housing system that creates and perpetuates barriers to progress. We are committed to transforming the system that shapes housing. By advocating for bold policies, fostering innovative partnerships, and engaging in community-driven solutions, we're looking upstream to address root causes of the housing crisis.

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CORNERSTONE HOUSING® INITIATIVE

Our Cornerstone Housing® Initiative frames the solution sets needed to address the housing crisis. It also introduces a systems thinking approach to policy development. Through research and community engagement, the initiative seeks to create a more equitable, sustainable, and accessible housing system by fostering collective action among stakeholders.

A strong housing system has three components:



Housing Supply Ladder:
Restoring balance in the housing market with adequate supply across the tiers of housing, facilitating progression from entry-level to aging in place.

Capable Demand:
Enabling sustainable demand from buyers each with the financial capacity and self-sustaining capability to secure and maintain decent housing that fits their needs.

Reflexive Safety Net:
Integrating an evolved social service model to provide a rapid and coordinated response that breaks the cycle of dependency and builds capable demand.
