## **Habitat Orlando & Osceola and Williams Company celebrate new homeowners with home dedication in Holden Heights**

**(ORLANDO, Fla.) Feb. 11, 2026** – [Habitat for Humanity Greater Orlando & Osceola County](#) and local construction company [Williams Company](#) celebrated a local family closing on the purchase of their brand new, affordable home in Orange County’s Holden Heights neighborhood on Wednesday.

“We are proud to have partnered again with Williams Company to help build a stable, affordable home for a local family,” said Habitat for Humanity Greater Orlando & Osceola County President & CEO Catherine Steck McManus. “Home is where health is nurtured, education is strengthened, opportunities are unlocked, and a place where lifetime memories are made. Today, and every day, we’re grateful to help build foundations for those memories.”

Williams Company, along with their subcontractors and vendors, donated the time, labor, and materials to build the Habitat home in Orange County’s Holden Heights neighborhood as part of the sixth annual Home for the Holidays event. While this home dedication was rescheduled after being postponed in December, it still brought some holiday cheer to February. A local family – Veronica, Marc and their three children – closed on the purchase of the home just hours before Wednesday’s celebration.

Veronica and Marc are excited to provide a foundation for their children – ages 2, 3 and 13 – to build their futures. They said being in a home that they own will help provide their family with much-dreamed-of stability. Veronica is already spreading the word about the Habitat program, encouraging her best friend to apply. “I can’t wait to inspire others and let that joy inspire me,” she said.

This year marks the sixth consecutive year of partnership between Williams Company and Habitat Orlando & Osceola, and this year’s home was the seventh one built by Williams Company and their subcontractors and vendors as part of the Home for the Holidays event.

“We are proud to have been a part of Habitat Orlando & Osceola’s mission for the last six years. Our partnership exemplifies the essence of people coming together to support one another,” said Williams Company Vice President of Operations Matt Olberding.

Since 2022, Habitat Orlando & Osceola has built 32 homes in Holden Heights – bringing the total to more than 60 homes constructed by Habitat in the neighborhood.
