(Feb. 12, 2022) — In a continued partnership with [Habitat for Humanity Greater Orlando & Osceola County](#), the [Enterprise Mobility](#) team volunteered to bring a Central Florida family's stable, affordable home another step closer to completion. On Thursday, a team of more than a dozen volunteers from Enterprise Mobility helped hang siding on the exterior of a Habitat home under construction in the historic Holden Heights community.
