Position Description

Summary/Objective

Assist Habitat for Humanity Greater Orlando and Osceola County by guiding less experienced volunteers on the construction sites and helping to educate them about construction and our mission.

Type

Volunteer, Part-time

Specific Responsibilities

- Assist with requested aspects of the construction of homes
- Provide leadership, guidance, direction, and safety instruction to small groups of four-to-five volunteers on the construction sites
- Assist in loading and unloading of building materials and tools on site
- Attend online crew leader trainings annually
- Ensure that all policies and safety standards are followed at construction sites

Requirements

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Understands Habitat Orlando & Osceola's mission
- Works well independently as well as with groups
- Strong communication & leadership skills; as understanding and communication of safety and technical instructions to volunteers is a significant part of this role, English fluency is required
- Ability to work under the direction of Habitat staff and comply with all on-site guidance and instructions, recognizing Habitat staff as the final authority on the build site
- Demonstrates mutual respect towards supervisors, volunteers, and partner families

The Construction Crew Leader Volunteer will regularly work on an active construction build site. Proper personal protective equipment will be provided by the affiliate. This position will be trained on various construction tasks and tool usage, but should only perform tasks they are comfortable with and should only lead tasks they are trained by Habitat staff for. The Construction Crew Leader Volunteer may be requested to use ladders, lift up to 50 pounds regularly, and able to work in varied weather conditions (including heat and humidity). Individuals in this position must successfully pass a level one background screening as well as sign an annual volunteer waiver.
